


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About BURI







On a BGIS project in 2022, Buri sustainably resourced 2 organisations to donate for reuse 1150m2 of existing marine carpet. The 2 organisations were:


- √ 150m2 to l'Mpossible, a unique physical and emotional development wellness program for people with a disability; and






